The new *MedEdPORTAL* [Anti-racism Education Collection](#) provides educators with practice-based, peer-reviewed resources to teach anti-racist knowledge and clinical skills, elevates the educational scholarship of anti-racist curricula, and aims to convene a community of collaborators dedicated to the elimination of racism within medical education. To specifically support developers of and educators in anti-racist curricula, we also offer individualized mentorship for potential authors.

MedEdPORTAL invites authors, owners and contributors to submit their works for publication consideration. We seek teaching activities and assessment approaches directly related to:

- Racism
- Microaggressions
- Trauma-informed care
- Implicit bias, health disparities, and/or social determinants of health where racism is a significant component

MedEdPORTAL publications are stand-alone, complete teaching or learning modules that have been implemented and evaluated with medical or dental trainees or practitioners. Each submission is reviewed by editorial staff and external peer reviewers using a standardized review instrument grounded in the tenets of educational scholarship.
